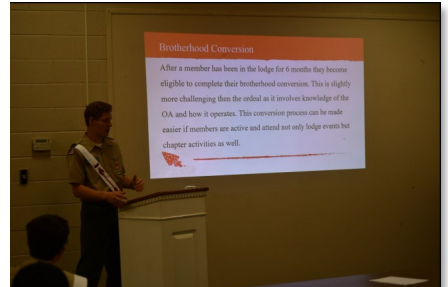
SPRING TAP OUT
